



FSAA-Performance Task Content Area Administration Update

Based upon recent questions and feedback presented to the Florida Department of Education regarding content area administration order of the Spring 2016 Florida Standards Alternate Assessment (FSAA) Performance Task, the following change has been made:

- The administration order of content areas as outlined in the Test Booklet and the Teacher Administration Manual (p.29 - instructs teachers to administer ELA first and then Mathematics) **has been changed from a mandatory administration procedure to recommended best practice.** Teachers may use their discretion to determine the order of content areas administered (i.e., some teachers may choose to administer mathematics before ELA) based on what is in the best interest of the student.

Please note that only the order in which a content area is administered may be flexible. Sessions within each content area (Session 1, Session 2 and Session 3) MUST be administered sequentially, as they are presented in the Test Booklet.
