Subject: 2016-17 Florida Standards Alternate Assessment -Performance Task

Dear Alternate Assessment Coordinator/ IEP Team Members,

In recent communications from our office, as well as from Measured Progress, you have received information related to the changes to the Florida Standards Alternate Assessment (FSAA) program for the 2016-17 school year. You were informed that for those students who would participate in statewide assessment via the FSAA-Performance Task, that IEP teams also needed to consider if the student would be administered the assessment in a computer based format or to continue using the paper version. However, it has now been decided that the 2016-17 FSAA-Performance Task assessment will be administered in the **same mode** as this year's assessment, thus postponing the release of student interface computer-based testing. Please disregard all recently released information related to this step in the decision-making process. We are editing all documents to reflect this change and will post revised documents to the FSAA Portal (<https://fsaa-training.onlinehelp.measuredprogress.org/>).
