

Dear Alternate Assessment Coordinators,

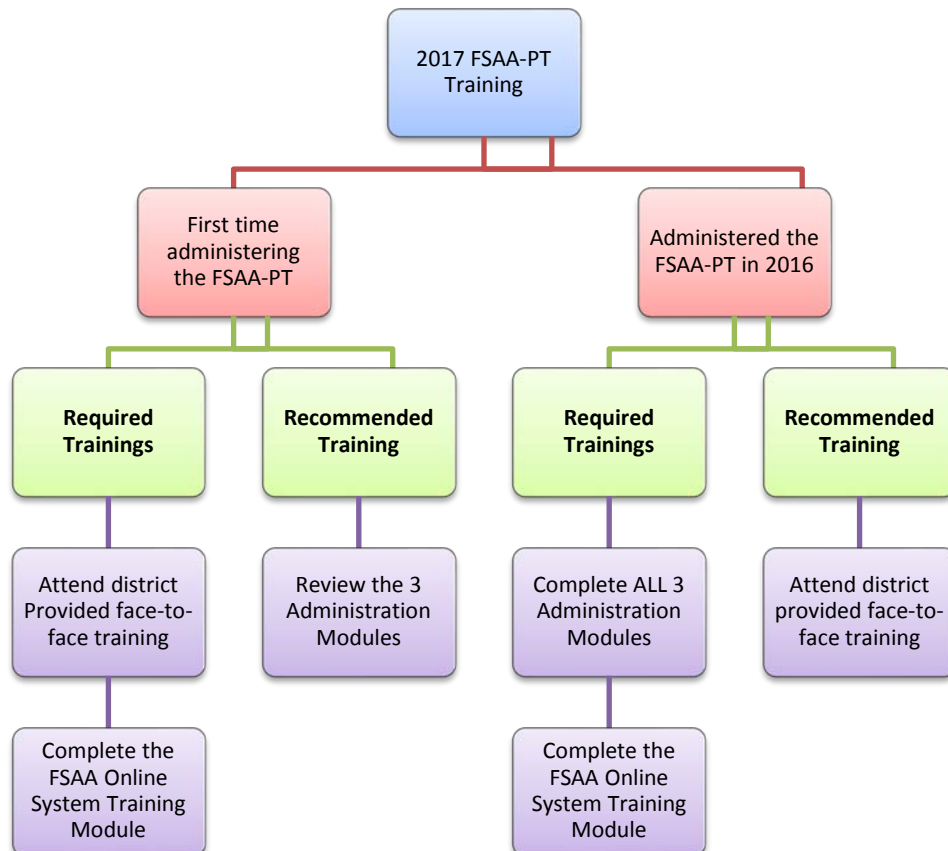
Please disseminate the following information to teachers and appropriate staff members participating in the 2017 Florida Alternate Assessment - Performance Task (FSAA-PT) Administration. **Alternate Assessment Coordinators are responsible for ensuring all eligible teachers have completed training prior to administering the spring 2017 FSAA-PT.**

The modules are available to educators 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

All teachers are required to participate in administration training prior to administering the spring 2017 assessment to students. Training can be accomplished through a combination of district provided face-to-face trainings and completion of training modules online depending on a teacher's prior assessment administration experience. Please note that ALL teachers will be required to complete the Online System Training Modules when they are released in February 2017. Certificates will not be distributed via email after teachers complete a training module. If certificates are needed for personal records they must be printed at the time of module completion.
