



Standard Setting

The Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), in collaboration with Measured Progress, is currently recruiting panelists for the Florida Standards Alternate Assessment – Performance Task Standard Setting Meeting that will take place the week of February 13, 2017. Standard setting is the process of developing “cut scores” that will be used to classify a student’s performance relative to achievement levels. This process is one of the most critical aspects of test development. Participants of the standard setting committees will be responsible for determining and recommending cut scores for the Florida Standards Alternate Assessment – Performance Task. Professionals from Measured Progress will organize and conduct the standard setting process in coordination with the FLDOE.

We are seeking approximately 110 panelists comprised of special education teachers, general education teachers, and administrators. Selected panelists will participate on one of eleven committees specific to content and grade level.

Measured Progress will arrange and pay for overnight accommodations for attendees traveling more than 50 miles to the meeting. A stipend of \$175.00 a day will be paid to individuals who are not under contract. Districts providing a substitute for an attendee will be reimbursed for this cost.
