



## 2019–2020 Practice Materials Refresh

Practice materials refresh kits have been created to use in conjunction with previously distributed practice materials to prepare for the FSAA—Performance Task. The practice materials refresh kits will be made available in three formats:

- **Electronic:** Materials are currently available to print from the FSAA Portal at <https://fsaa-training.onlinehelp.measuredprogress.org/performance-task-teacher-resources/>.
- **Paper-based:** Materials will be delivered to Alternate Assessment Coordinators (AACs) for distribution to teachers in late September.
- **Accommodated braille/tactile:** Materials will be available for students with visual impairments and will be delivered to AACs for distribution to teachers in late October.

### Please note:

- Practice materials provide teachers and students with the opportunity to become familiar with the assessment materials, the administration procedures, the type of preparation needed by the teacher, the anticipated student mode of communication to answer selected- and open-response items, pacing, administration duration, and more.
- Practice materials can be used throughout the school year and from one year to the next as a tool for students and teachers to gain greater familiarity with the administration of the FSAA—Performance Task.
- Practice materials are not secure, and, therefore, any part of the materials may be reproduced.
- Practice materials should not be discarded, shredded, or returned to AACs after use.
