Please distribute the following information to teachers participating in the 2020–2021 administration of the Florida Standards Alternate Assessment—Performance Task (FSAA—PT).

For the 2020–2021 school year, the Florida Department of Education is initiating an additional data collection process for students who are being instructed on alternate achievement standards, also known as Access Points, and assessed through the FSAA—PT. This process involves the use of the Learner Characteristics Inventory (LCI) to collect educational information about the characteristics of students with the most significant cognitive disabilities.
