



## Cognitive Processing Survey

Dear Alternate Assessment Coordinator,

**Please distribute this message and encourage teachers and any other trained district staff who administered the Spring 2021 Florida Standards Alternate Assessment—Performance Task (FSAA—PT) to participate in the survey.**

Now through June 30, 2021, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) is conducting a statewide survey to gather insights from teachers. These insights are based on their experienced observations and inferences about student cognitive processing. We are targeting certain FSAA—PT items that are intended to elicit different thinking processes when responding to these item types.

All information regarding you (the teacher), your responses to the survey, and your students is anonymous. The focus of the survey is on student thinking (cognitive processing) and will not be used to evaluate instructional practices or student learning. All teachers' anonymous responses will be compiled at the state level only and used for improvement purposes and as part of our required peer review submission to USED. The total time required to complete the survey is approximately 10 minutes.
